 Metropolitan College is teaming up with partners to develop a self-assessment tool for humanities professors. This tool will help them gauge their knowledge and skills in STEM and identify areas for growth.

 Innovation Hive will collect results from humanities professors across partner countries. Mykolas Romeris University and Wroclaw University of Science and Technology will use this data to create an online training program, supported by the partners. This online training will uplift professors' skills in STEM.

 Metropolitan College will lead the creation of a STEM Teaching Handbook. This resource will empower humanities professors to seamlessly integrate STEM into their curricula and offer exciting cross-disciplinary courses to their students.

 The University of Macerata coordinate all project activities. Meanwhile, the Georgian Int University and the Ivan Franco National University of Lviv are diving deep into the effective implementation of these actions.

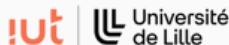


What's Next
