Scholarships for prospective students

MRU Tuition fee waiver for Bachelor degree studies

Who can apply?

Applicants for Bachelor degree studies who are citizens or permanent residents of Ukraine (5 grants), Colombia (2 grants), Azerbaijan (2 grants), Georgia (Sakartvelo) (1 grant), Brazil (1 grant), Kazakhstan (1 grant), Uzbekistan (1 grant).

Financial provisions:

Scholarship covers the full tuition fee for the whole period of Bachelor degree studies for students accepted in the academic year 2025-2026, if they have no academic debts.

Criteria:

- Candidates are selected based on their grade point average (GPA) and English proficiency level.
- The GPA must be at least 8.5, and the English proficiency level must be at least B2.
- Candidates with an English proficiency level of C1 or higher receive an additional 0.5 points added to their GPA.
- Applicants for studies in the Lithuanian language receive an additional 1 point.
- If multiple candidates achieve the same score, preference is given to those applying to programs with fewer eligible candidates for Tuition fee waiver.
- If five or more top-scoring candidates (from any country) apply for the same program, preference is given to those with slightly lower scores applying to programs with fewer eligible candidates for Tuition fee waiver. In this case, their score may be up to 0.5 points lower than the last of the top-ranked candidates.
- If there is only one eligible candidate from a specific country, they are selected regardless of whether their chosen program has five or more eligible candidates, and the above rule does not apply.

State scholarships for full-time master degree studies

Each year, the Education Exchanges Support Foundation opens applications for Lithuanian state scholarships for international full-time Master's degree students accepted at Lithuanian higher education institutions.

The scholarship includes a monthly stipend and a grant covering study costs.

Scholarships for citizens of Kazakhstan

Who can apply?

Applicants for Bachelor or Master degree studies who are citizens of Kazakhstan.

Financial provisions:

Full tuition fee coverage for the whole study period.

Criteria:

- Excellent academic results from previous education
- English language proficiency (at least B2 level)
- 1 recommendation letter from teacher who is well aware of candidate's academic excellence
- Statement from the Center for International Programs or from Bolashaq Development Fund that a candidate is pre-selected for scholarship

MRU Senate scholarships

Who can apply?

Bachelor and Master degree students, regardless of their country and type of financing.

Financial provisions:

The size of the scholarship varies from 27,5 EUR to 1650 EUR depending on the particular scholarship type.

Criteria:

Very good learning results and active involvement in sports, artistic, scientific and social activities.

MRU Incentive scholarships

Who can apply?

Best-performing Bachelor or Master degree students (state-funded and non state-funded) from target foreign countries*.

Financial provisions:

1,5 BSB (1 BSB = 55 Eur) provided 2 times per year (autumn semester (September-January)/ spring semester (February-June)) and is paid monthly.

Criteria:

Best-performing students in the academic unit are determined each semester by their learning results (average of the last session grades – at least 8).

*List of the countries is approved by the Rector on the proposal of the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs.

MRU Incentive scholarships

Who can apply?

Scholarships for short-term studies in Lithuania offered for candidates who are citizens of the following countries:

- Azerbaijan, Armenia, Australia, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Brunei, Cambodia, Canada, China, Georgia, India, Indonesia, Israel, Japan, Kazakhstan, Laos, Malaysia, Moldova, Mongolia

Myanmar, New Zealand, Pakistan, the Philippines, Republic of South Africa, Singapore, South Korea, Thailand, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates, the USA, Vietnam.

- Foreigners of Lithuanian origin (from all foreign countries).

Financial provisions:

- -550 euros per month for Bachelor and Master degree students
- -1100 euros per month for PhD and resident students

MRU Incentive scholarships

The doctoral education is financed by state assignments and tuition fees.

The state also provides competitive financing opportunities that are organized by the Research Council of Lithuania. These programmes offer funding for candidate's internships, participation in

national as well as international scientific events abroad, and also financing for academic staff visiting Lithuania to deliver lectures for doctoral students and to participate in doctoral thesis defense.

Additional financial support to doctoral candidates may be provided on the bases of the national or international programmes, ex. Erasmus, The Marie Skłodowska-Curie actions (MSCA) and etc.
