An Erasmus+ traineeship abroad for recent graduates is a traineeship carried out after graduation from Mykolas Romeris University. Erasmus+ traineeship for recent graduates is intended to provide recent graduates with the experience they need to thrive in today's job market.

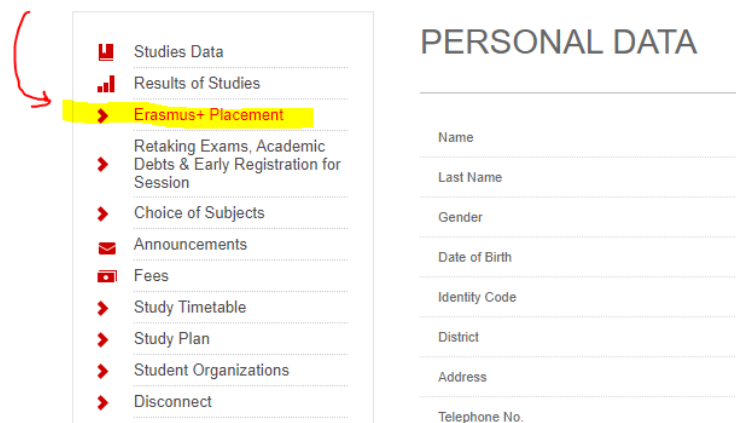
**Opportunity to all (BA, MA or PhD International Full-time Students
at Mykolas Romeris University!**

If you have successfully defended your final thesis, passed all exams, and are on the verge of graduation, this is an exciting opportunity for you. Those with a Temporary Residence Permit or, for EU citizens, a Certificate of Temporary Residence in Lithuania (allowing an additional period of 9 or 12 months for employment search) are eligible to **apply for the Erasmus+ traineeship grant for recent graduates.**

To avail of this opportunity, **students must apply before officially graduating from the University.** Please note that applications will not be accepted after graduation.

Ensure you **submit your application to reserve your grant even if you have not yet found the hosting organization before the deadline on January 19th, 2024.** Don't miss out on this chance to kickstart your post-graduate journey!

*Graduates can plan to undertake their Erasmus+ traineeship within a minimum period of 10 months from the day of graduation, allowing at least 2 months (60 days) for the internship itself.

* The Erasmus+ grant will cover the duration of two months for recent graduates, while the remaining duration is available with zero grant, maintaining the status of Erasmus student. If the duration for international non-EU citizen student graduates exceeds the 90-day visa-free period, a visa for the accepting country will be required.

*The departure for the Erasmus+ traineeship for recent graduates is formalized in the same way as for a currently studying student.
