The Fulbright Graduate Student Program offers grants for Lithuanian citizens who intend to enter graduate master's degree programs or, for current PhD students, non-degree programs at U.S. universities in any field. Annual competition opens in January.

Fulbright Graduate Student Program for Academic Year 2026-2027

Application Deadline: **June 2, 2025**

Eligibility requirements for all applicants:

- you must be a citizen of Lithuania;
- you must possess an undergraduate (bachelor's) university degree;
- you must have clearly defined study goals and career objectives;
- you must have an excellent academic record and be proficient in English as appropriate for your proposed course of study in the U.S.;
- you must live, study and/or work in Lithuania at the time of the application and during the affiliation process; and
- you must not have had an academic experience in the U.S. within the last five years.

There is no requirement to register with the Embassy before applying to the program (in the application mark "Yes").

The following must be included in the online application:

- three (3) letters of reference;
- official academic transcripts in Lithuanian and in English;
- copies of diplomas; and
- a copy of official TOEFL results, if available.

The Fulbright Schuman Program awards scholarships to European Ph.D. students to study or conduct research with a focus on EU affairs/policy, or the US-EU transatlantic agenda at an accredited U.S. institution for a period between four months and one academic year. Academic/professional experience of 3+ months in two or more EU Member States is recommended. The program is administered by the Fulbright commission in Belgium.



Study of the U.S. Institutes (SUSI) for Student Leaders are five-week academic programs on the topics of civic engagement, entrepreneurship and environmental issues for first, second, and third-year undergraduate students. The SUSI for Student Leaders programs consist of seminar discussions, readings, group presentations, and lectures, and a one-week integrated study tour. Annual competition opens around November/December.
